DDA SERVICES

CTP's Developmental Disability Agency (DDA) provides individually tailored services to help children feel successful in daily interactions at home and in the community. Our evidenced-based services include:

- Habilitative Skill
- Behavior Intervention
- Interdisciplinary Training
- Community-Based Supports

HABILITATIVE SKILL

This direct intervention service includes techniques used to develop, improve, and maintain the developmentally appropriate functional abilities and daily living skills needed for growth. This service is for those who need additional training for daily living skills, social skills, task attention, and transitions.

BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION

Behavior Intervention is used to teach children the skills necessary for positive changes in behavior to improve learning and self-regulation. Behavior Intervention is for children who exhibit interfering behaviors that impact the independence or abilities of the individual, such as impaired social skills, communication, or destructive behaviors.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TRAINING

This service can be used in collaboration with Speech & Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Mental Health Counseling, and other medical professionals. Interdisciplinary Training is for any individual who is already receiving additional services.



COMMUNITY-BASED SUPPORTS

A skilled professional provides a child with the opportunity to practice skills learned in other therapeutic and natural environments through participation in community settings. Community-Based Supports is for children who already have the foundational skills required for safe and effective community participation but need assistance honing those skills.
